Interest rate change rules after the initial applicable interest rate period ends		<ul> <li>After the initial interest rate period ends, the interest rate will be determined based on the second house loan base rate (floating rate, 1 year renewal) as of the month preceding each interest rate change. The same rule will be applied on future interest rate changes while floating interest rate is in effect.</li> <li>By applying to SMBC Trust Bank, you can select a second house loan with a fixed rate for 3, 5, 7, 10 years. In this case the rate will be determined based on the base interest rate for the applicable interest period.</li> <li>Customers who change to fixed rate loans can make their selection among 3, 5, 7, or 10 year fixed rate interest terms either by phone (anytime) or at branches (within business hours). However, there is a fee for making this selection.</li> <li>When applications to change to a fixed interest rate loan are made by 4:30 p.m. on the 23rd of each month (the previous business day when this date falls on a bank holiday), the change date will be the 26th of the previous month. Applications made after 4:30 p.m. on the 23rd to the end of the month will take effect on the 26th of the current month.
